

B.I.K.E.S. Meeting Minutes

Thursday Sept 11, 2008 7:00pm

Members attending: Bill Weber, Doug Andrews, Steve Hudspeth, Tim Wise, Warren Bare, Mike Dahlstrom, Mary Andrews, John Carlin and Art Arneson

President Bill Weber opened the meeting.

Old Business:

- Zippy's Bike Rack Update: The City of Everett has agreed to change their policy and subsidize part of the cost of bike racks for downtown businesses. Marilyn Rosenberg pled her case to the City Council and they will help her. No grant increase is necessary.

New Business:

- Warren Bare provided an update on advocacy in the county. Bicycle Exit signs fixed for the following streets: Cathcart Way and Hwy. 9; Airport Way and Hwy 99; 164th St and Ash Way (Lynnwood); Hwy 9 and 20th St NE has push button crossing for bikes and peds. Also the bike lane on the east end of 112th bridge was widened away from the sidewalk, where it terminated.
- Three new bike lanes in Lynnwood will be painted on 168th, 188th and 208th streets.
- Mt. Lake Terrace's Lake Ballinger trail is getting further work/extension.
- The City of Mukilteo wants input from BIKES in the future for their 6 year Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP).

Ride Leading Responsibilities:

Steve Hudspeth, Ride Miles Coordinator, asked that Ride Leaders please ensure that all riders, and guest riders, have accurate information on the sign up sheet:

1. Clearly indicated who is a guest and who is a member
2. Accurately record printed name for easy interpretation
3. Get information to Steve in a timely manner

Election

Bill Weber suggested that that election be scheduled for this October for the coming year. President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer are up for reelection. BIKES Constitution requires a nominating committee be appointed by Bill consisting of at least 3 non officer club members.
