

To the Residents of the Ibberson Plat:

The purpose of the letter is to advise you as to the status of the Silver Lake Trail Project. We appreciate the feedback received and the healthy conversation around this project.

The City of Everett has decided it is in the best interest of the project to move forward at this time with some, but not all, of the trail improvements. The City will not at this time use the right of way in front of lots 1 and 2 or East or West Ibberson Drive for the proposed trail. The City will proceed with the design for construction of the trail, including multiple segments through TA Sullivan Park.

At some point in the future, the City may proceed with the trail segments in front of lots 1 and 2 and on East and West Ibberson Drive. However, we do not expect any decision on those segments to occur for a number of years. The City understands that residents desire more communication specific to these proposed trail segments. There will be communication and discussion prior to any decision being made in the future regarding these trail segments.

City staff will be providing a project update at a virtual public meeting on Tuesday, March 30 at 6:30pm. Information and instructions for attending the virtual meeting can be accessed through the link provided. everettwa.gov/silverlakepath
